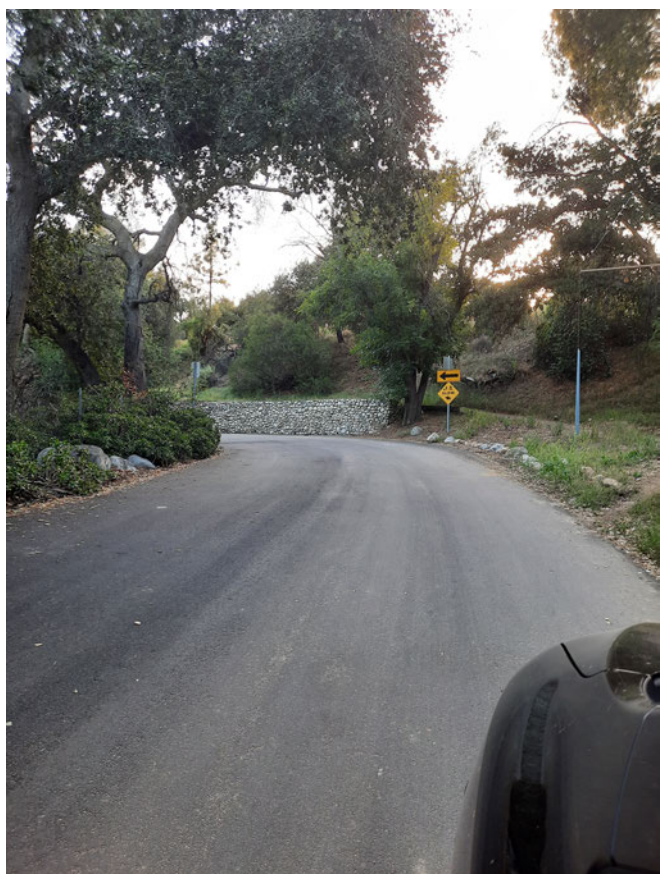

# CAUTION: SLOW DOWN!

## USE CAUTION ON THE BLIND CURVE OUTSIDE RBR GATE!

Many RBR members drive too fast and do not stay on the appropriate side of the road when entering or departing RBR. Use caution when driving through the park and especially this curve. Don't be cause of a devastating accident and stop frightening our horses and their riders!
